GREEN COMMITTEE: SOLAR PANEL DEDICATION



In 2022, the Green Committee was started by resident volunteers on the Prairie Ridge campus. The volunteers were made aware of Renew Wisconsin and their Annual Climate Summit. At the Summit, volunteers were introduced to Legacy Solar Co-op, which is a not-for-profit dedicated to helping nonprofits finance solar panel installations. The volunteers determination to this project has now concluded with 222 panels on the south-facing roof of Settlers Ridge.

A solar panel dedication occurred on the afternoon of Tuesday February 6th, 2024. Speakers included Green Committee Chair, Oakwood Village Foundation, Prairie Ridge Executive Director, Facilities Services Director, Legacy Solar Co-op, Olson Solar, and State Senator Melissa Agard.
